Residence permit and entitlement to attend an integration course

Foreign nationals usually need permission for their stay in Germany. To request a residence permit as well as further questions regarding your residence status and for the provision of your right to residence please contact the Immigration Office at the District Administration Offices (Landratsamt) in Roth. There you can also acquire authorization for participation on an integration course.

Integration Courses

Integration courses are aimed at acquiring language skills and knowledge of the social, cultural and economic life in Germany, including its norms and values. The integration course, as a rule, consists of a language course (up to 600 hours) and a basic orientation course (45 hours). Newly arrived immigrants, German emigrants returning to Germany and asylum seekers are primarily entitled to participate. Other immigrants may be admitted upon application. One hour of tuition costs €1.00. For persons in need there is no cost.

Documents of entitlement can be obtained from the Immigration Office, the ARGE or the Federal Offices for Migration and Refugees.

The certificate DEUTSCH B1 will be awarded upon completion of the course. This will improve your chances of integration in the job market. You can provide evidence of language skills necessary for your right of residence and you can shorten the waiting period for your naturalization in Germany by 1 year, from 8 to 7 years.
